Entry fee

The entry fee of DKK 950 includes dinner on Friday and Saturday, breakfast & packed lunch on Friday, Saturday and Sunday and refreshments after the races.

Meals for guests (spouses, friends and others) on Friday or Saturday is 150 DKK per person per day.

Grill and potato salad Thursday evening at DKK 80,- for competitors as well as guests.

Competitors' entry fee (DKK 950 plus DKK 80,- if you want to include Thursday) and DKK 150 per meal per guest on Friday/Saturday must be paid for your registration to be valid and payment is due by 15th August at the latest. Bank Reg. no. 2047 Account no. 8975 819 702 or MobilePay 70655.

Competitors from outside Denmark may pay for at the race office on arrival.

Late entry fee: An additional amount of DKK 300 applies if you register after the 15th of August. Registration is not possible after the 20th of August.

Rules

The regatta will be governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing including the prescriptions of the Nordic Sailing Federation and Dansk Sejlunion. The rules for Danish Championship will apply. Rule 42 will apply and the jury will be at the course to check if any rule is breached.

The Racing Rules will be changed in the Sailing Instructions:

RRS 26, 28, 32, 33, 35 (A4 & A5), 60.1(a), 61.1(b), 62.1(a), 62.2, 66 and A4.

Sailing Instructions will be available at this site no later than 2 days before the regatta starts.

Insurance and membership of Sailing Club

Each participating boat must be insured by a valid third-party liability insurance. Documentation will be requested at registration.

Each participant must be a member of a Sailing Club referring to the national Sailing Union. Documentation for this will be requested at registration.
